

Bedford Springs July 15 1841

Dear Sir

Since I wrote you I had an interview with Mr Singleton in relation to your fee. he seems disposed to deal by you justly. if you have not been paid he says you ought to be, but he thinks you have or ought to have received a pretty liberal fee. he says at one time he left with Mr Wm Byrne \$100= for you I think he is charged with \$75= more paid you, he wishes you to write say what amounts you have rec^d on account of your services as his attorney. He would feel himself much obliged if you would at some leisure time make out a statement of all the judgments & decrees, I can only act as Mr Singleton may instruct in the matter you may direct your communication to me if you choose & I will have it conveyed to Mr Singleton
