

Greensburg Aug 9th 1830

Dear Sir after I returned home I found there was
more of the heirs than I had expected
but you will find the certificate enclosed in this
letter of the legal heirs and the proof of their
heirs is made by their father and I
believe the proof is entirely ^{as he is not at all interested} sufficient, but
if it is not you will inform me immedi-
ately and I will attend to the same agreeable to
your instructions on my return home I came
by John Bains and got the names of all the heirs
and he promised me to send me the proof but
has yet not done it. I therefore only send you
a list of their names as the said Bains told me
and I have no doubt but they are the legal heirs
Rebecca Bains married William T. Burford
Maria Bains Rhoda Bains married James
Hawkins William Bains Lucinda Bains is
in her fifteenth year and if myself or any other
person legally authorized to represent the heirs
of S. Barks ^{will come up this fall} I wish you to inform me by letter as
soon as you receive this whether there could
not be a final settlement made or not

I wish you to let John Tucker know that I went to
see Benjamin Lewis the next day after I
returned home and he frequently promised to pay
me the money for him but did not do it
and as court was near at hand I thought it
best to sue him and will attend to the same
to the best advantage I give my compliments
to William Stoughton & family and let him
know that I was at Mr Elias Barbers a few
days ago and him and family was well
