

Glasgow 9th August 1843

Messrs Glazett & Page
Gentlemen

I wrote to you on my arrival in Glasgow, that it was my intention to set off from Liverpool in a Vessel which was to sail from that Port on the 25th of July, accordingly, I arrived there with my Family on the 12^{3rd} but was dissatisfied all the berths in the Vessel being engaged, - I secured berths for myself & Family in another Vessel which was to have sailed afterwards, but after spending seven or eight days waiting for her departure I grew unwell so much so that with the advice of medical men I declined to proceed on the voyage, I therefore returned to Glasgow on my way to Portsmouth where I am at present.
