

At a Court of Hastings held for the Town Incorporation of
Fredericksburg, on the 12th day of January 1843.

John Buck in Person & Hugh M. Patton by
note in Writing, under his hand and seal, two of the Executors
named in the Will of Anthony Buck deed, renounced the Execu-
torship of the said Will; And on the Motion of John L. Mays, who
made Oath thereunto, according to law, and with Geomans Smith
and Samuel Alsop his Securities, the latter of whom qualified as
to his Sufficiency, entered into and Acknowledged a bond in
the Penalty of \$20,000. conditioned as the law directs; Certifi-
cate is granted him for obtaining Letters of Administration on
the said Anthony Buck's Estate, with his Will, heretofore proved
and recorded in this Court, annexed, in due form.
