I find on examining my vouchers as administrator of the estate of Capt George Rogers dec^d, an account against the said Rogers for goods purch^d from Saul Weaver & Co proven before Charles Ming Esq by Samuel Hunter on the 31st day of October 1825 for the sum of \$22.60 and paid by me, as pr receipt, to Samuel Weaver on the 7th Dec^r 1827 amounting at that time with interest to \$25.12 which appears on the account I also find an account against me receipted, for Samuel Weaver for the sum of \$1.50 which was for the purchase of three gallons of whiskey for the 15th Nov^r 1825 and intended to be used at the sale of the property belonging to the estate of the said decedent. This last rec^t is dated 7th Dec^r 1827. There I presume are the acct^s to which you allude in your letter to me of the 21st of Feby 1846 which reached me a few hours past.
