The Will of John Holladay, dated Dec 7, 1742 names the following children: - John, Daniel, Joseph, Benjamin, Elizabeth (wife of Patterson Pulliam) Winnefred "now the wife of Thomas Pulliam", Sarah, Susanna. The administrators were Joseph and Benjamin Holladay and "his son-in-law" Thomas Pulliam.

The Will of John Roswell - wife Ann - names the following children, all minors in disposing of 980 acres of land to his sons: - Dorothy, Frances, Ransom, John, George, and James.

The Will of Thomas Pulliam^(I) dated April 14, 1758 names the following children: - James, Thomas^(II), Winnefred, Anna, Susanna, Elizabeth, ~~Susanna~~, Agness, Mary, Benjamin, Isabella.

This certifies that in the "Report from the Secretary of War... In relation to the Pension Establishment of the United States" (Washington 1835) Vol 2 page 128 of the part of the volume that contains the Virginia Pension Roll, appears an entry which shows that Thomas Puckett was a private in the Virginia Militia in the Revolutionary War. His name appears in a list of pensioners of the United States living at that time in Cuckpers Lee, Virginia. His name was found on the pension roll April 8, 1833 and his pension \$20.00 a ~~month~~ year commenced March 4, 1831. His age is given as 72 years

and Rhody his wife to them, their heirs, and
assigns forever - - - " Recorded June 25, 1829.

The Will was witnessed by Thomas Pulliam
and Keziah Lillard, the daughter of Absalom
Lillard who ~~was~~ lived with Rhoda Pulliam.
