To wit

Lloyd Logan
Complainant of Servis S. Pitcher
alias S. S. Pitcher in custody of
of a plea that he render to the said
Plaintiff the sum of fifty two
dollars and eleven cents which
he owes to the said plaintiff and
unjustly detains from him.
And thereupon the said plaintiff saith
that heretofore to wit on the 1st day
of January 1849 at the County of
Fairfax the said Servis S. Pitcher
by the name of S. S. Pitcher
by his certain writing obligatory sealed
with his seal and now shewn to the
Court the date whereof is the day
and year last aforesaid prom-
ised and obliged himself to pay to
the said Plaintiff one day after
the date thereof the sum of
Fifty two and $\frac{11}{100}$ Dollars for value
received. And the Plaintiff avers
that although the said sum of
fifty two dollars and eleven cents
in the said writing obligatory spec-
ified hath according to the tenor
and effect of the said writing obligatory
been long since due and payable
and although the said defendant
hath been often requested to pay
the same to the said Plaintiff yet
the said defendant hath not paid

to the said plaintiffs the said
 sum of money or any part
 thereof but to pay the same to
 the said plaintiffs with interests
 wholly neglected and refused and
 still doth neglect and refuse
 so to do: to the damage of the said
 plaintiffs fifty dollars: and
 thereupon he brings his suit as
