Ransom Pulliam

Writ of Capt. Benjamin Lillard, "My will and desire is that all my just debts shall be paid out of my estate by my executor and the residue and remainder both real and personal together with all debts due or which may become due I give and bequeath to Ransom Pulliam and Rhoda, his wife to them their heirs and assigns for ever.

I appoint ~~appoint~~ Ransom Pulliam and Rhoda wife executor and executrix of this my last will and testament. . . . I witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 6th day of November, 1828"

Witnessed by Thomas Pulliam and Legiah Lillard.
Will recorded June 25, 1829. Mas. H. B. 5. 257

(I have a note that Legiah Lillard was the daughter of Asa Lillard who lived with Rhoda Pulliam)

The widow Ann married Wm. Gatewood.
Frances Russell married Thomas Pulliam I accord-
ing to a statement by their great grandson French,
Puddledon Carter (Mrs Vincent Smith's father) and this is
corroborated by the appearance of the names of Russell,
Ransom and Frances in later generations. So far,
I have not found a legal statement. My own
mother was Frances Pulliam named for Francis
Billard Carter mother of F. F. Carter who in turn was
named for her mother Frances Pulliam (Hysle)illard.
