



Know all men by these presents. That we William Foster, & Sally Foster,  
(wife of the said William) of the county of Muskingum, and state of Ohio,  
have made, constituted and appointed, and by these presents do make, con-  
stitute and appoint Martin Thompson, of Culpepper county, Virginia, our  
true and lawful attorney, for us and in our name, to sell, grant and  
convey absolutely in fee simple, for such sum of money, and to such per-  
son or persons as he shall think fit and convenient, all our right, title, and  
interest, in and to certain land and premises, situate in said Culpepper county,  
Virginia, being the farm on which William Foster, late of said County of Cul-  
pepper, now deceased, lived and died, containing about two hundred and four  
acres, and which said right, title and interest descended to said William Foster,  
of Muskingum County, Ohio, as one of the children and heirs of said deceased,  
and we do hereby authorize our said attorney for us and in our name to seal  
execute, and deliver such deed or deeds of conveyance for the absolute sale & sale  
of our said interest, or any part thereof, with such clauses, and covenants to the  
therein contained, as our said attorney shall think and expedient,  
hereby ratifying and confirming such conveyance which shall hereafter  
be sealed and executed by our said attorney touching and concerning the  
premises
