

Morse Genealogy

Thomas Andrew¹ Morse settled in Maryland in 1647. He took sides against Lord Baltimore; and at the end of the trouble fled across the Potomac to Mattot, where many of the Protestants sought refuge. He married Elizabeth — and died before 1668, when a deed from his widow Elizabeth to his children names them as Elizabeth who married Bunch Roe Susan Andrew,² George and William.

Andrew² Morse born 1664 married Elinor Spence daughter of Captain Patrick Spence and had issue Elizabeth Andrew Spence and Susannah who married Charles Tyler. Andrew died 1713.
Andrew³ died 1735, leaving a wife Christian and Children

Elmer, who married Dr James
Bankhead, Sarah, Spence, and
Andrew.

Spence ⁽⁴⁴⁾ married Elizabeth Jones
sister Hon Joseph Jones and
had James ⁽⁵⁷⁾ Pres of U. S., Andrew,
Joseph Jones and Elizabeth who
married William Buckner.

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
